SAS Original Hitchlock HL1 Instructions

The Original Hitchlock is available in 2 different models to suit some braked and unbraked trailers. These instructions cover the HL1 which is mainly suited to trailers with braked hitches. If you have a tall single drawbar, or a stand under the hitch and drawbar and this is hindering this hitchlock from fitting you may need the HL2 model instead.

The hitchlock comprises of two main parts - the painted outer section, and the inner silver section.

To separate the two sections: -

- Insert your radial tumbler key into the hitchlock lock at the top corner of the coloured outer section.
- 2. Turn the key 90 degrees to unlock, then slide the inner silver section out of the outer.

To fit onto hitch: -

- The red label on the silver section has "HITCHED" and "UNHITCHED" on - one reading correctly and the other inverted. Slide the inner silver section over the hitch from one side, ensuring the red label reads correctly for depending whether you are fitting on a hitch that is hitched or unhitched to vehicle or other hitch point.
- Now slide the coloured outer section over the inner silver section from the opposite side of the hitch. Insert the key and turn to unlock, to ensure that the two sections are full pushed together, then rotate key in the lock 90 degrees and remove key.
- 3. Ensure the inner section is locked into the outer.

TMPORTANT

- It is imperative that the hitchlock is fitted correctly for effective protection.
- 2. Never move or drive vehicle with the hitch lock fitted.
